

GETTING STARTED WITH YOUR NEW MOKE

Your keychain contains a zip drive. This zip drive includes your Owner's Manual, Charger Manual and Warranties for the vehicle and batteries.

RED BATTERY BUTTON

This is the battery kill switch. It's the most important thing to remember. Always push it in when the Moke is not in use, or the battery can and will drain. Pull it out to run the car, push it in when you are done.

KEY

Turns on the Moke after the red button is pulled out. The dash will say READY in green; your car is on at that point (it does not make a sound; the light indicates it is powered up).

EMERGENCY BRAKE

This gearshift has no "Park" position on it. It is forward to drive, down to reverse, neutral is in the middle. The emergency brake must always be pulled up when you are not in the Moke. Think of it the same as putting car in Park.

TECHNICAL SUPPORT

Under the hood is a huge sticker with our phone number. If anything ever goes wrong, just call that number. Our techs will look at the Moke through FaceTime or Skype to diagnose it, and can work that way with your local mechanic should they need assistance.

BLUETOOTH STEREO AND PHONE

There is a small mode button above volume. Hit this twice until it says BT. Then just go to your phone to BT and you should see it pop up as BMP.

CHARGING

Your power cord will be in the back lockbox (trunk). It plugs in above the driver side front tire under the wheel well. The red button should be pulled out to charge (on position when charging) then it just plugs into the wall. (**RECOMMENDED**) There is a little light by the tire and flashing means your car is charging. 6-8 hours for full charge, approx. 40 miles on a charge. On your dash to the right it will show how much battery power you have.

EXTENSION CORD

If you need to use an extension cord to reach the outlet, please make sure it is a 12-gauge outdoor weatherproof cord. Here is a link to a bunch of them on Amazon. We always recommend keeping one in the trunk in case you charge somewhere on the go and can't get close enough to an outlet.

LIGHTS

The lights are right above stereo. One button is to light up the dash, the other is headlights. The brights are on the side of steering wheel.

WINDSHIELD WIPERS

You may need to take a safety pin or something thin and turn the nozzles towards the windshield. They may be pointed straight up, just turn it with the pin.
